





Indiana's Tax Credit Scholarship Program was created in 2009 to give families who meet income guidelines an opportunity to send their child to a participating private or charter school. Every year, over 90% of Providence students benefit from such scholarship gifts. Indiana businesses or residents can also benefit from this program because the tax credit is equal to 50% of the amount donated and can be used to reduce Indiana state income tax liability.
